Dear Prayer Warriors,

As 2019 began, I found myself looking back over the years and counting all of the Lord's blessings since 1997. Twenty-two years ago, God led me, by faith, to establish the Thailand Women's Ministry. Since then, it has been a very exciting adventure because everything has occurred by faith. The journey has been rough and tough; the road has been hilly and winding. There were times when I thought I would not be able to make it, but the Lord was always faithful in encouraging me and carrying me. I sensed His anointing and His supportive hands every step of the way. I praise God for all His goodness and mercy as well as His calling upon my life.

Also, I am so grateful, especially for my supporters. Your faithful financial support has meant so much to me and the people who have been blessed through this

ministry. You certainly play a very important role in the Thai people's lives that have been touched by God's Word. Although I have not had very many financial supporters these past 22 years, God has overseen every detail of



my life. In Him, I have not lacked for any good thing. Thank you once again to my supporters. Please envision a big hug from me!

Currently, I am preparing the teaching for two important events in Chiang Mai, that will occur:

- April 24-26, a youth camp.
- April 29-May 3, a women's retreat.

The above events are the result of what God did at the Lahu tribe women's retreat that I taught at last year. I am leaning on God as I make my preparations to meet the spiritual needs of these hungry souls. Please join me in prayer in asking God to do great and mighty works in the lives of these tribal women.

Regarding my eye condition, it has deteriorated again over the past three months. God has graciously led me to a new military hospital where I found a kind Christian ophthalmologist. He is using the most effective, yet expensive medication (which the government pays for); a medication that other hospitals have refused to use on me due to the high cost. I thank the Lord for His provision. Now, I no longer need to fly to the US to get this same medication.



Since last October, I have barely been able to sit because of my back problem. I do my Bible reading while lying on my stomach and prepare my weekly teaching (typing and reading) while standing. Pain stays with

me 24 hours a day, and most of the time it's hard to fall asleep. Since December, God has provided me with a therapist who seems to know how to deal with my back problem and shoulder pain, but it's very expensive! So, I

see her once a week for special treatments and I am beginning to feel a lot better. Please pray that God will heal me completely so that I can sit without any pain.
