Dear Prayer Warriors,

I am happy to report that due to God’s loving care, everything went well during my last two speaking engagements with the Lahu tribe in Chiang Mai. I am allergic to smoke so with the weather being extremely hot and the air being filled with smoke from many burning fields and forests in this northern region of Thailand, I was concerned about getting through both events. God answered our prayers and got me



through them before I fell sick!

It was exciting to see that a combined total of two hundred children and youth attended the camp. The children were taught

about God by speakers from Myanmar, while the youth were taught by me and a few other speakers. It was a great opportunity to implant God’s Word into their hearts because these students knew very little about God or the Bible. Also, I was very thankful to have



Edwina, a missionary from South Africa, as my prayer intercessor during the youth camp.

Before the women’s retreat began, some of the men reported to me the effect that last year’s retreat had on the women. They shared with joy and gladness saying that the women’s lives had



been transformed so that the husbands were happy and the churches were blessed. Because of that outcome, this year, the men volunteered to do all the cooking so that their wives could attend the retreat! It was such a beautiful picture to see the men working hard in supporting their wives in this way.

We had 150 women turn up this year which was almost triple the size of last year. Although our meeting room had no air conditioning and the temperature was over 100 degrees Fahrenheit, we made it through the event by God’s grace. I was the only speaker during those five days, and God was my strength. The



women were very attentive to the teaching of the Word. I praise God for their receptive hearts and their willingness to learn. During our final session, many shared openly and humbly some of the things they learned from the Word of God. They repented of their sins and said that they had never been taught in such a way before. They truly desire to be a blessing to their families and are trusting God to improve their

roles as wives and mothers. I give God all the glory and honor because He has done it all. I was grateful to the Lord to have had Lisa Lehman as my prayer intercessor during the women's retreat. (Lisa is the person who previously gave me a short training on writing, and she is now doing the translation of my study book from Thai into English!)
