Due to these health problems, the work on my book has been on hold since last September because I just can't do any work on the computer! I am still in a lot of pain while working on this newsletter.



Despite my physical problems, I managed, by God's grace, to complete five days of teaching at a women's retreat this past September. The Hmong women were greatly blessed, and they want me to return to their mountain homeland to teach every year! Another wonderful result is that the pastor's wife of the host church has come under Benz (my co-worker) and my

discipleship and is faithfully attending our Bible teachings.



So far, the study has been going very well and I have already noticed some in the group who show a lot of potential in their hunger and thirst for the truth. By February 7, I will begin another online Bible study group, using the book I have written, "The One True God" to lead them. By the way, Benz, who lives in Chattanooga, TN, has been using the book to lead her study groups with non-believers and she has been finding it easy and very effective! Just recently, a Buddhist woman in her group gave her life to the Lord. Praise the Lord!
