

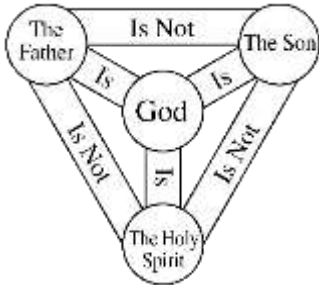
The Christmas Trinity, Part 1
