Dear Praying Friends,

A few months ago, I was praying about resuming my weekly Bible study and establishing a discipleship group, since my sabbatical year was over and I was feeling much better physically. I asked God to raise up women with potential, who had never been discipled before, and lead them to me, as I did not know where to find them. A few weeks later, God led me to introduce my teachings on my YouTube channel to a new contact of mine. After she started listening, she quickly and excitedly introduced my teaching channel to her close friends while expressing thankfulness to God. She told me that she had never heard this kind of sound teaching before, especially because it focused on meeting the spiritual needs of women, and had changed her life drastically in such a short period of time. Sadly, she is unable to join the discipleship group and only God knows why. Please keep her in your prayers.

A few days later, other women who had listened to my teachings came to my house, asking me to begin discipling them right away. I was pleasantly shocked, as I had not expected God to answer my prayer so quickly and so specifically. Sensing their genuine hunger and sincere desire to be taught and discipled by me, I responded immediately with joy and thankfulness to God.

The Women in My Discipleship Group



Lyn: I joined this discipleship group because I wanted to live my life according to God's will and become a “Proverbs 31” woman. I desire to be the kind of wife and mother who aligns herself with God's design, and I also hope to use all the lessons I learn to teach and build up other women.

Cherry: I am a daughter of the founder of New Vision Baptist Church in Bangkok. My parents passed away when I was a young girl. Before my father passed, he gave me the instruction—regardless of the circumstances, never abandon God or the church. Currently, I serve

as the president of the church's mission committee, and I am in great need of God's wisdom to fulfill my responsibilities. Recently, a friend sent me a teaching link titled “God's Will for Women”. When I listened to it, I was so excited by the



message, because it focused on being obedient to God and following the roles He has laid out for us as women. This is a topic which no one has ever taught us before, and it's the main reason I decided to join the discipleship group.



Aom: I am very interested in Chanaddah's teaching because there are not many study lessons available that focus specifically on women. I want to learn about the roles of women, and what kind of woman pleases God. I do not just want to complete the study, but I want my life to be changed as well so that I might be a blessing to others.

Lydia: My main goal in joining the discipleship group is to fulfill the Great Commission according to Matthew 28:19, and that is to be built up as a true disciple of Jesus so that, in the future, I can also make disciples.



Jun: I am a single parent because my husband passed away four years ago. I have a 19-year-old daughter who is a freshman at university. I am concerned that many people in today's society have wrong views about sex and life partners, and make abnormal behaviors seem normal. I do not want my daughter to adopt those kinds of ideas. Instead, I want to instill in her and every young woman the desire to be a Godly woman. If she chooses to have a partner, I want her to keep her marriage bed pure and not follow the ways of the world. I want her to demonstrate the value of life as a child of God and be a good example to society, and stand out as a rare and virtuous example in this world that is so full of corruption. I believe that the

lessons I will learn from Chanaddah will help me understand God's will more clearly, so that I can be used by Him in His ministry.

My (Mary Noi) discipleship strategy begins with an orientation, and follows with giving them assignments. These include: listening daily to specific topics of my teachings on my YouTube channel, reading 10 chapters of the Bible each day, memorizing the names of all 66 books of the Bible, memorizing Proverb 31:10-31, and more. I also have taught them effective memorization techniques. Believe it or not, they have successfully completed all these assignments and were surprised that they were able to do it. 😊 I also meet with them weekly for additional teaching. I have them doing all these foundational activities because they have never read through the whole Bible. This is very typical as over 95% of Thai Christians have not done so. It's one of the main reasons why Thai churches do not grow. The congregation only hears topical preaching each week and knows very little about Scripture. It's the sad truth. 😞 In fact, trying to find an oasis in the desert would be a lot easier than finding a church with sound doctrine in Thailand.

It has been seven weeks since my discipleship group began, and already, amazing and beautiful transformations are occurring in the disciples' lives. Due to the impact the discipling is having on them, they are spreading the word about my teachings to others and sharing the link to them on my YouTube channel. One man, in particular, has been excitedly telling others about the incredible change he has seen in his wife, saying that it is very much like having a new wonderful wife! Praise God for the way His Word has been positively impacting their lives. To God be the glory for all that He has done.



My Mother and I: Once my discipleship group began, I made a trip to my mother's place in northeast Thailand on May 21. The main purpose was to read my book "Knowing the One True God" to her and spend quality time with family members. My mother is 92 years old and in good health but I sensed an urgency to share the Gospel with her again while I still had the opportunity, as life is full of uncertainties. Since May 24, I have been reading my book to her slowly and faithfully, providing explanations as we go. She enjoys it immensely. On June 12, after I finished reading chapter 9, she prayed to receive Christ. I made sure to explain the Gospel to her with supporting Scripture verses, and clearly explained why Jesus had to die on the cross for our sins. Since she has

Alzheimer's, I am not quite sure where she stands in her relationship with Christ. I keep asking her almost every day if she is sure that Jesus is in her life and her answer is always positive. Please pray that she may truly understand what it means to have Jesus Christ in her life as her only Savior and Lord. Pray also that she may stop worshipping other gods out of fear of offending other people. I will continue to read the Bible to her until I return to Bangkok on July 15.

I am glad to report that the condition of my eyes has greatly improved, although I still receive eye injections, but not as often. I praise God for His goodness and faithfulness. Thank you for keeping my health in your prayers.
