Cherry: This discipleship group is helping me learn how to follow God in a more meaningful way. I have been strengthened both in my faith and relationship with God. I never thought I could read ten chapters a day and memorize chapters and verses, but I am doing that. 😊

Lynn: For the past five months, I have been very disciplined in reading ten chapters of the Bible per day (sometimes more). I have also been able to memorize Scripture— something I never thought I could do. Most importantly, I am growing and learning how to study the Bible through observation, interpretation, and practical application. My four-year-old son is also learning to memorize Scripture verses. Praise God!



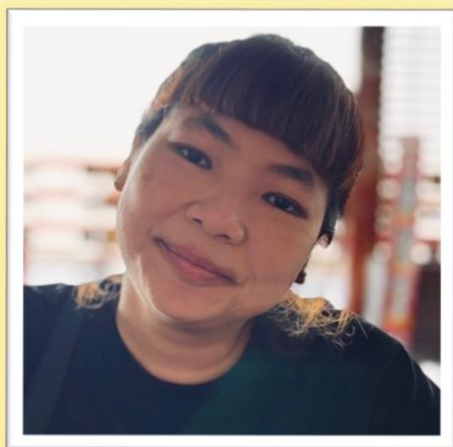


Lynn was checking Cherry's Scripture memorization, making sure she got every verse right! (This took place during a break at church camp). You can see how faithful they are in doing their homework.
