Big Idea: God's grace is not for sale. It is a gift that cannot be purchased or earned.

1. THE GREAT STORYTELLER

- a. God loves to teach us through parables, metaphors, parables, and true stories of events that truly occurred.
- b. Stories teach complicated truths in accessible packages. (Matthew 13:43b)
- c. Stories allow us to learn from the examples of others. (Philippians 4:9)

2. PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS – 2 Kings 5:1-12

- a. Naaman had a problem...
- b. He attempted to solve his problem.
- c. He was frustrated by the solution offered.

3. OBEDIENCE AND OPPORTUNITY – 2 Kings 5:13-19a

- a. Naaman was challenged to reconsider...
- b. He obeyed and was healed!
- c. He returned to Elisha payment in hand.

He left with dirt.
